

## Topic – Yabadabadoo!

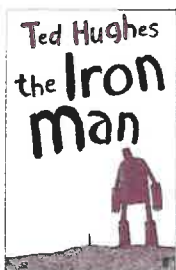
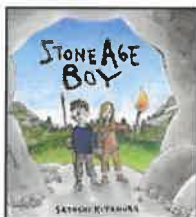


Our topic for this term is 'Yabadabadoo!' Through our History lessons we will develop a chronological understanding of the Stone Age and construct the past using a range of sources. We will discover how people survived using the technology available and how much change occurred over the three parts of the Stone Age,

In our Geography lessons, we will learn what volcanoes and earthquakes are. We will discover how they change the physical features of the world and how they impact on the lives of people.

## English

In our English lessons we will focus on sentence structure. We will be learning what makes a sentence and the importance of accurate punctuation. We will continue to develop joined up handwriting and improve the legibility, consistency and quality of handwriting across the curriculum. Our writing will be based on our topic work and the book 'Stone Age Boy'. Later in the term, we will be exploring how to make our writing more engaging through the use of expanded noun phrases and different forms of sentences.



Our class reading book will be 'The Iron Man'. We will be focusing on developing our scan and skim strategies to improve our retrieval. We will also be working on developing our understanding through the development of our vocabulary.

## Newsletter – Autumn Term 2025

### **Year 3**

Welcome to the Year 3 Curriculum Newsletter. This is a summary of the learning planned for the Summer Term.

## Science

In our Science lessons we will be discovering how rocks are formed and how they can help us to learn about the past. Later in the term, we will be learning the importance of healthy eating and how diets affect our bodies.

## Maths

We will begin the term by adding and subtracting across ten before moving onto exploring numbers to 1000. Children will be able to use known facts to find multiples of ten that compose 100. We will then move onto adding and subtracting two and three digit numbers using the column methods.

Club sheets will continue to be tested weekly and there is a homework expectation that your child plays TT Rockstars on a regular basis. We will consolidate the four calculations through daily Fluent in Five sessions and a weekly arithmetic lesson.

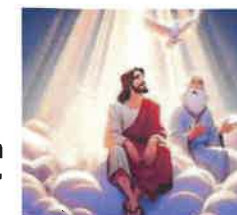
## PE
