This topic will also include designing our own clay animals in Design and Technology.




English

Maths

Our focus to start the term will be to develop an understanding of addition using the column method. We will be focusing on adding a pair of 2-digit numbers using the column addition method. Pupils should be able to use their knowledge of column addition to solve problems while identifying the addends and the sum in column addition. Children in Dove will also be continuing to learn the 3, 4x, 6x and 7x tables and continued practice at

home would help secure these facts.

Science

This term we will begin by learning all about 'Light'. Children will learn that dark is the absence of light, notice that light is reflected from surfaces and recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by a solid object.

All children in Dove class will have a PE lesson on a Friday morning with Soccer 2000. Please ensure that your child has their PE kit (including joggers) in school as it is expected all children participate.
