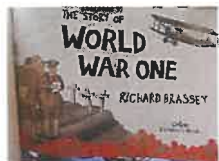

Topic

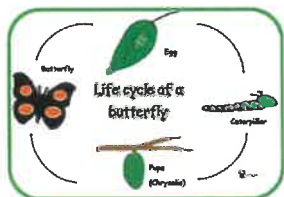
Our topic for summer 1 is 'A passport to Jamaica.' The focus will be map work and comparing Jamaica to Wolverhampton focusing on the physical and human geography.



The topic for summer 2 is 'World War one.' The focus will be on the impact this had and what life was like during this time.

Science

We will be learning about animals, including humans, in our science lessons; we will be learning about the animals off-spring and the lifecycles.



Maths

Over the summer term, we will continue to cover the maths curriculum, as well as securing the children's learning from the previous objectives learnt. Children will start with a focus on number, leading into addition and subtraction methods. We will be using a range of different resources and pictures to enable the children to develop their number skills.

Read Write Inc

We will continue to have daily phonics lessons, following the Read Write Inc programme - most of us will be revising our set 2 sounds to help us read words accurately and to become more fluent readers.

English

This half term, we will begin by exploring known stories. We will be describing the characters in the story and developing our reading skills.

Later in the term, we will explore other genres such as non-chronological reports and postcards. We will also be introducing the children to the wonderful world of George's Marvellous Medicine by Roald Dahl.



RE

Our key question in RE this half term will be 'What are Christian places of Worship like?' We will consider what is sacred to us. We will visit St Michael's Church to help us name some of the different features within different churches. Our key question next half term will be 'What does it mean to belong to a community?'

PSHEe

Our PSHEe topics for this term will be growing up and Relationships. We will be focusing on how to respect ourselves and others. We will also start to look at changes in ourselves and others. We will continue to focus on our Mental Health and learning how we can improve it.

Further Information

Our topic day will be a 'Jamaica' themed day. The children can come to school dressed in the colours of the Jamaican flag - black, green and yellow. We will be celebrating all things Caribbean! More details to follow this half term.

Every Monday is forest schools. The children need to come in their outdoor clothes and outdoor shoes.

PE

In the Summer Term, we will be exploring multi-skills such as running, jumping, skipping, hitting and kicking. They will also be developing skills in decision making and improving their awareness of others during games and activities.

Dove will have PE on a **Thursday**. Robin will have PE on a **Tuesday**. Please ensure children come to school in their PE kits for the lesson. Children may wear black pumps or comfortable trainers. Please can you remove any earrings on these days.
