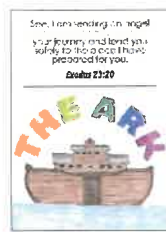

Preparing for the Boreatton Park Residential Visit: 4th November – 8th November 2024

Please read the following information and attached leaflet about the forthcoming trip. If you have any questions, please raise them on September 26th at the parents' meeting or, if you are unable to attend, contact Mrs Rogers or Mrs Navratil.

- Please limit baggage to one case or bag per child and one small bag (eg. Backpack) for items needed on the journey.
- Your child will also need to bring their own pillow and sleeping bag. Please make sure they are securely wrapped (eg. in a large plastic bag) so they don't get damp or dirty on the journey.
- All essential activity equipment is provided. Your child will need to bring clothing, footwear, wash bag and towels (please see the kit list in the attached leaflet). Spray deodorants can set off the smoke alarms, so please send roll-on deodorants instead.
- All clothing should be marked with your child's name and they need to know what they have in their bags so that they can find things easily. Please pack everything with your child so they know what they have.
- The children are allowed to bring up to £10 spending money: there is a shop onsite and the children will be given an opportunity to visit this once during our stay to buy souvenirs and treats. Please ensure that their money is in a wallet/purse which is clearly marked with your child's name. These will be handed to the teachers on the Monday morning and given to the children when they visit the shop.
- NO VALUABLES should be taken to Boreatton – no mobile phones, electronic games, extra money or any other valuable items. They are not needed.
- Jewellery cannot be worn for the activities so please ensure children do not bring earrings or other jewellery. Long hair needs to be tied up for all activities – please make sure your child has plenty of hair ties if needed.

 - ☐ Fleece/jumpers



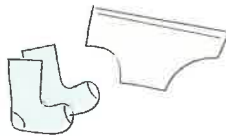
Your arms will need to be covered to do some activities.
