Dear Parents / Carers,





Preparing for the Osmington Bay Residential Visit: 5th March – 7th March 2025

Please read the following information and attached leaflet about the forthcoming trip. If you have any questions, please raise them on Thursday 23rd January at the parents' meeting or, if you are unable to attend contact Mrs Dutton.

- Please limit baggage to one case or bag per child and one small bag (e.g a backpack) for the items needed on the journey.
- All essential activity equipment is provided. Your child will need to bring clothing, footwear, wash bag and towel (please see the kit list in the attached leaflet). Spray deodorant can set off the smoke alarms, so please send roll-on deodorant instead.
- All clothing should be clearly marked with your child's name and they need to know what they have in their bags so that they can find things easily. Please pack everything with your child so they know what they have.
- The children are allowed to bring up to £10 spending money: there is a shop onsite
 and the children will have an opportunity to visit this once during our stay to buy
 souvenirs and treats. Please ensure that their money is in a wallet/purse which is
 clearly marked with your child's name. These will be handed to the teachers on the
 Wednesday morning and given to the children when they visit the shop.
- NO VALUABLES should be taken to Osmington Bay no mobile phones, electronic games, extra money or any other valuable items. They are not needed.
- Jewellery cannot be worn for the activities so please ensure children do not wear or bring earrings or other jewellery. Long hair needs to be tied up for all activities – please make sure your child has plenty of hair ties if needed.
- Any medication your child may need for the residential must be handed to a teacher prior to the visit and a medical form filled in.

Clothes are likely to suffer wear and tear and also get dirty and/or wet therefore you should bring several changes of old clothes for doing activities.


