Dear Parents,

As you will know, there is the opportunity for children at St Michael's to have musical tuition. At the start of a new school year there is the opportunity for new learners to join in. It is an excellent opportunity to develop the skills learnt in our whole class instrument lessons or to learn something new and presents very good value for money – private instrument tuition for individuals can be very expensive but learning in a small group at school makes the cost far more manageable.

This year, we are continuing to offer brass and violin and are hoping to add guitar as another instrument choice if there is enough interest.

Please complete the attached form if you would like your child to have the opportunity to learn a musical instrument in the next academic year, either as a new learner or continuing musical instrument lessons at St Michael's. Musical tuition for violin, brass or guitar for the year will cost a total of £150, payable in 2 instalments: £75 by 15th July this term, and £75 by 30th September 2025. If you would like to take this opportunity, please note that a place cannot be confirmed without payment of the initial instalment this term.

Forms must be returned **by Monday 23rd June** at the latest so that we can arrange the tuition. You will receive a letter confirming a tuition place has been offered later in the summer term once the groups have been organised.
