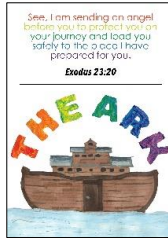

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Music Service Groups: calling all children and young people!

We have a wide range of **FREE** music groups for **all instruments, voices and ages**. Children and young people who are learning to play a musical instrument - whether that is with the Music Service or with another provider - have a number of options depending on which instrument and standard they are at. September is the month for young people to come and try a group. There's no need to pre-book or do anything in advance, they just need to turn up with their instrument at the right time. Children from Year 5 to Year 13 are also welcome to come along the **Youth Choir**, which is on Tuesdays 5.30 to 7.30pm. No experience necessary, and they will be singing a wide range of great music often chosen by the young people themselves.

Modern Music Production Course - Y6/7+

These courses run each term where participants learn music production skills using Macbooks and Logic X Pro. In partnership with local producer Detonator, young people receive top class instruction in music production including some studio time at Beatsabar studios at Newhampton Arts Centre (to be confirmed during the project).
