We are writing to remind you that Key Stage 2 National tests will take place during the week beginning Monday 11<sup>th</sup> May 2026. It is very important that your child attends school on each of these days and is on time. The timetable for the week is outlined below:

Wednesday 13 <sup>th</sup> May 2026	Maths Paper 1: Arithmetic Maths Paper 2: Reasoning
Thursday 14 <sup>th</sup> May 2026	Maths Paper 3: Reasoning

We want Year 6 pupils to sit the tests under the best conditions possible so that they can do their very best. Therefore, during test week, a free breakfast club will be on offer for all Year 6 children. Children can be dropped off at school at 8.00am and have breakfast with their classmates, ready for the day ahead of them, if you wish.

Local elections are taking place on **Thursday 7th May 2026** and once again St Michael's is being used as a polling station, however Year 6 pupils are expected to attend school as normal on this day and will be working alongside teachers in preparation for their upcoming SATs. Please make sure your child arrives in school at the normal time of 8.50am and is collected at 3.20pm. **There will be no bagel club or Giraffe Club available on this day.** On this day, your child will not be required to wear school uniform.
