On **Wednesday 3rd June**, Year 5 will be having an Anglo-Saxon and Viking topic day. On this day we will be exploring more about this period in British History and local history, as well as beginning our DT project for this term. On this day, we would like everyone to wear something connected with the Vikings if possible. You can keep this as simple as you like or as historically accurate as you can!



The colours found within Britain were primarily grey, brown, yellow and, and the material used was plain rather than pattern. Simple tunics (e.g. a large t-shirt with a belt) over trousers and simple dresses for girls, with or without a cloak, were common clothes. Anyone who wishes to be a Sword Dane – a fierce warrior – can come equipped for battle with a shield! It's worth noting that Viking warriors included women too...

The DT project will require cardboard so we would be grateful if you can collect and send into school empty cereal boxes/delivery boxes that we can cut up and use on our making day which will be later in the term.
